An AIDS Care Kit, delivered by MCC provided multi-vitamins, personal care items, towels and bed sheets. Beans, rice and maize from MCC's food program in Tanzania added to Tatu's hope for her children's future.

\$1.00 covers the cost of one HIV test kit in Tanzania

\$10.00 a month supplies one person with a supplemental food package which includes beans, corn, flour and sugar.
